Applicant must be at least 18 years of age, possess a GED or high school diploma, Emergency Medical Technician certification (EMT-I or EMT-A), Basic Life Support (BLS) certification, Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) certification; First Class Firefighter's Certification or NPQ I; Georgia Basic Firefighters certification. A valid class B driver's license and a satisfactory Motor Vehicle Record (MVR), good verbal and written communications, have some knowledge of applicable state laws and county ordinances and ability to communicate with the public on a daily basis. Applicant must be able to pass a Physical Agility Test along with Background Check and Drug Screen.
